

Notice the Flow












Find the Key/Legend

Look at the Sizes



How to Draw a Floorplan


Step-by-Step






1

Start with a square / rectangle

Add walls inside

Mark the **Doors** and **Windows**





Draw **Furniture** (Optional)

Use **Direction** Words
