Penguins are very interesting birds that live in the southern hemisphere. They don't use their ¹ _____ for flying like most birds. They use them like fish use their ² _____ to help them to swim fast. Penguins are very good at swimming. They can stay under water for about 20 minutes without coming up for air and they can swim as fast as 24 kilometres per hour. They have lots of black and white ³ _____, which keep them warm in cold places. They often stand close together to keep warm, too. They catch fish in their ⁴ _____ and eat them whole.

Unfortunately some penguins, for example, the Galapagos Penguin, are now endangered. This is because their habitat is in danger from pollution and climate change. Sometimes, they also get caught up in large fishing nets. We need to protect them so that they don't become extinct. If you want to help, then you can support organisations that protect endangered animals in the wild.
