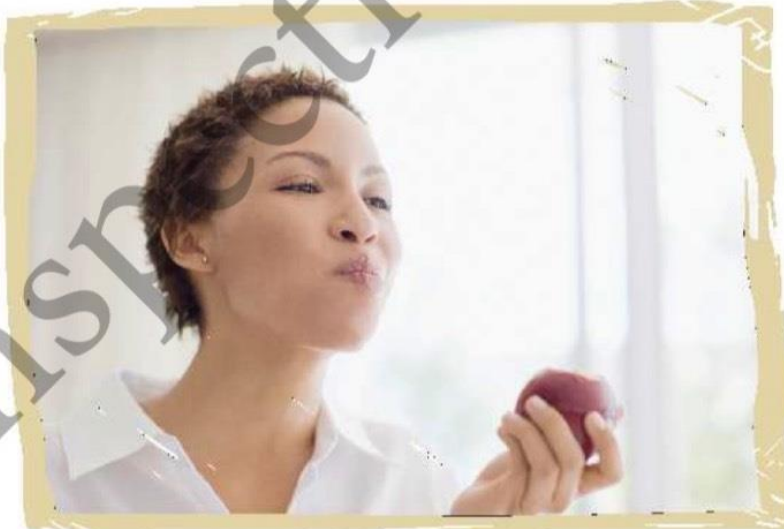

Short and long vowels
