The Red Sea

The Red Sea is a tropical sea. The water temperature is 30 - 35°C in the summer and about 25°C in the winter. The warm temperature makes it perfect for swimming and scuba diving. Lots of people visit the Red Sea to see the beautiful beaches, coral reefs and all the animals.



This is a lionfish. It has got beautiful colours but it can sting!

This is a baby leatherback turtle. Leatherback turtles are the biggest turtles in the Red Sea. They can grow up to 2 metres long; that's bigger than you! Turtles swim under the water but they also need to go to the surface to breathe.



The hammerhead shark eats lots of fish every day. Its eyes are far apart so it can see all the fish around it.
