Si-o-se-pol Bridge

There are 11 bridges over the Zayandehrud. The largest one is the **Allohverdi Bridge**, also known as Si-o-se-pol. Allahverdi Khan was the name of the man who supervised the process of constructing the bridge.

Si-o-se-pol was built between 1599 and 1602, during the reign of Shah Abbas. It is located right in the center of Isfahan. Its length is 297 meters and its width is 13.75 meters. In Farsi, "si-o-se" means 33, which is the number of arches of the first level of the bridge. The second level has pedestrian path where people can walk.
