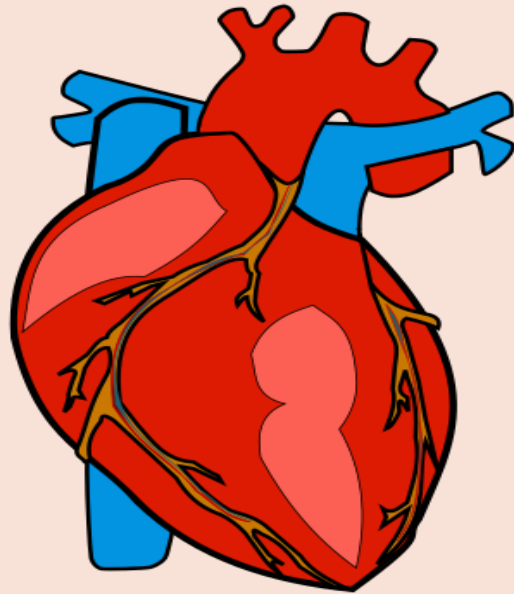


The major organs are heart, stomach, intestines, lungs, liver, kidneys and brain.
