




Why does our belly move in and out?




When we breathe in, the air enters our body.




When we breathe out, the air goes out of our body.

Which body organs help us breathe?




Our lungs are in the chest, behind the ribs.






Look at these stretchy sponges. They fill up with water.

How do we breathe?





Air enters our body through the nose or the mouth.

Air goes down the windpipe and into the lungs.


Air leaves the body through the nose or the mouth.


Air is squeezed through the lungs and travels up the windpipe.



















Air goes down and into the lungs.
