Plants make or **produce** their own food. They are **producers**.



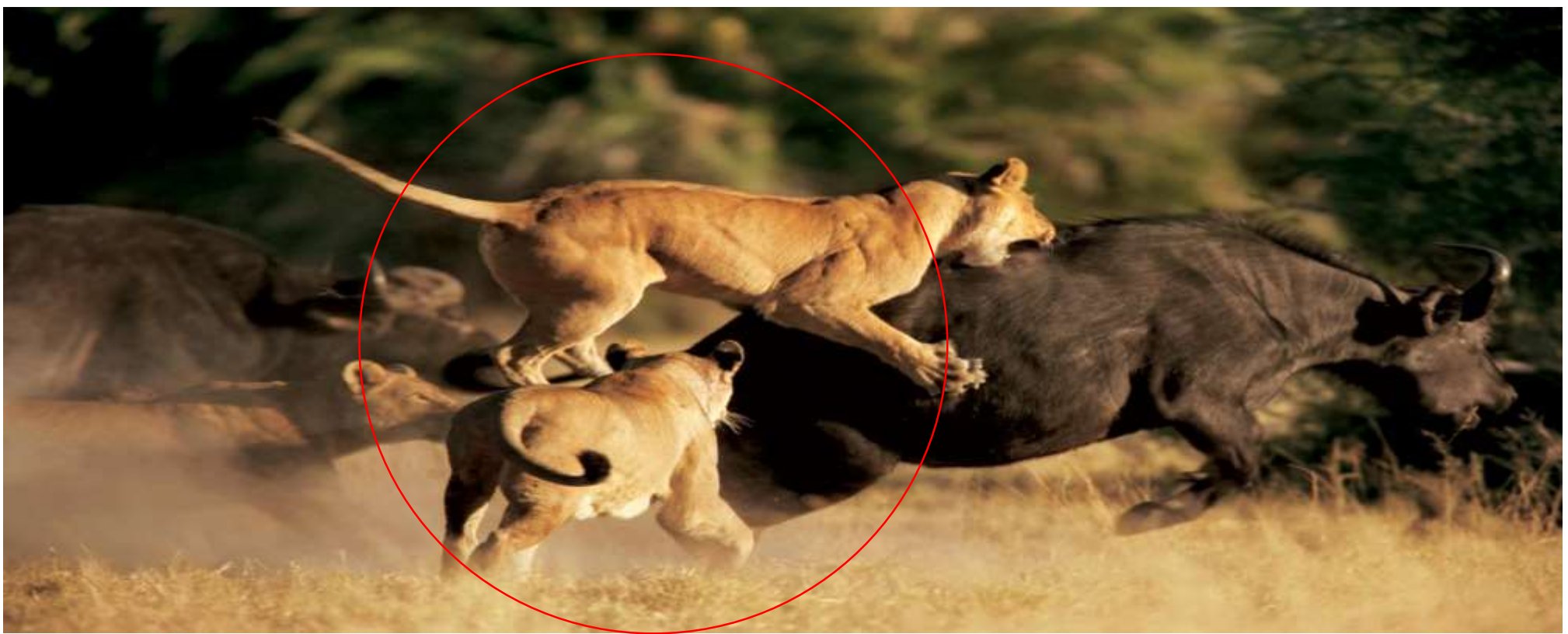


Animals and humans cannot produce their own food. They consume (eat) plants and animals. So they are consumers.



An animal that eats another animal is called  
"predator".

The animal that is eaten is called  
"prey".

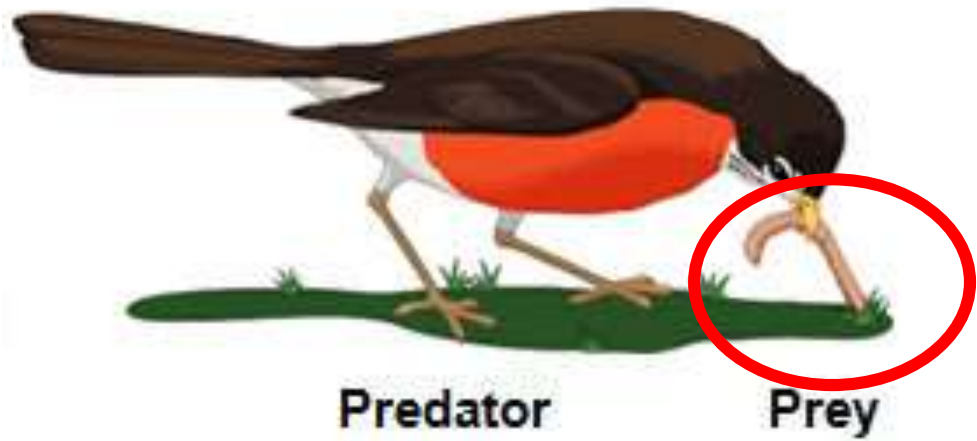

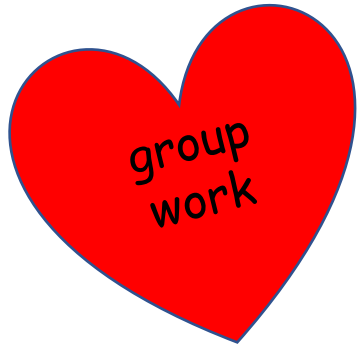
