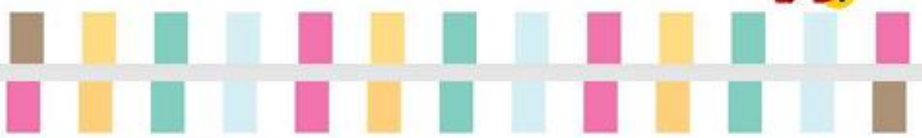




* 4.4. Animal habitats

A **habitat** is the home of an animal. Animals live in different places.
Look at the pictures. Draw a line from the habitat to the animal.
