This jacket costs \$85.00.

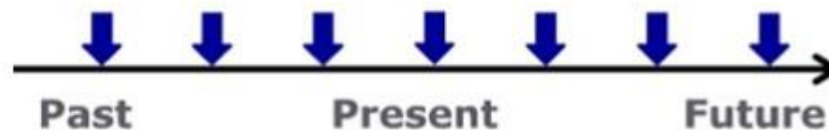


I live in Ecuador.

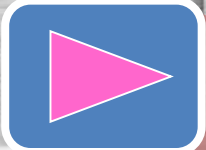
