NEGATIVE FORM

- In the negative form there is no difference between regular and irregular verbs.

- We need an auxiliary verb: **DID** + not

did not = didn't

- After **didn't** we add the **infinitive** of the verb

He studied → He **didn't** study

I went → He **didn't** go

Negative Sentences

SUBJECT + DIDN'T + VERB (base form)

I didn't work yesterday.

They didn't believe him.

INCORRECT: *I didn't worked

*They didn't believed



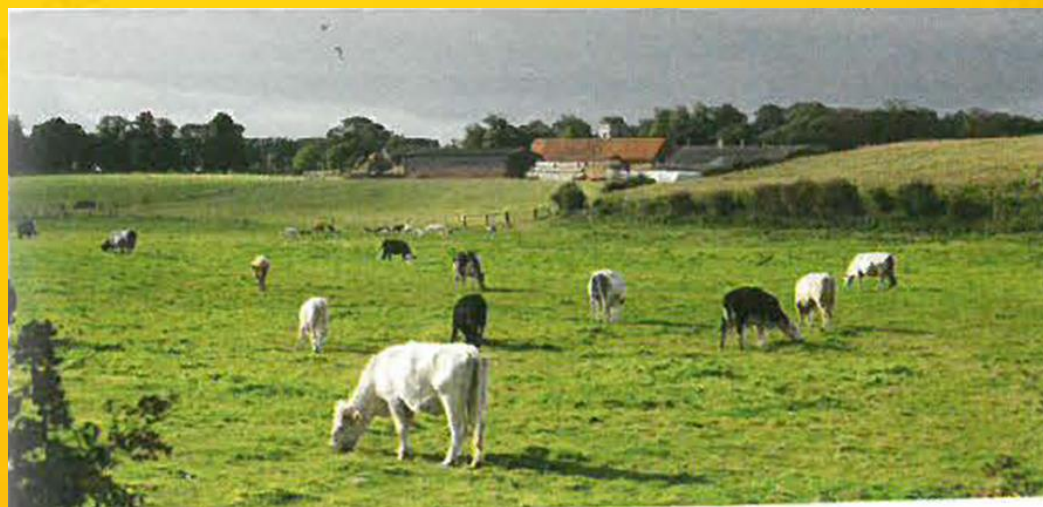
