

#### NEGATIVE FORM

- In the negative form there is no difference between regular and irregular verbs.
  - We need an auxiliary verb: DID + not

did not = didn't

After didn't we add the infinitive of the verb

He studied → He didn't study

I went  $\rightarrow$  He didn't go

#### Negative Sentences

SUBJECT + DIDN'T + VERB (base form)

I didn't work yesterday.

They didn't believe him.

INCORRECT: \*I didn't worked

\*They didn't believed


