PAST CONTINUOUS TENSE = WAS/WERE + VING


 To talk about actions in progress at a particular time in the past.





YESTERDAY AFTERNOON

They were playing table tennis yesterday afternoon.



Use the simple past for:

1) action that happened in the past and is

over, done, finished

Use the past continuous for:

1) action that was in progress at a specific point in the past OR

 focusing on an action that continued for a long time in the past




