Past Progressive Tense

(was or were) + (VERB + "ing")

On-going activity

Another activity

Past

Present

Future

PAST CONTINUOUS TENSE = WAS/WERE + VING

- To talk about **actions in progress** at a particular time **in the past**.



**What was he
doing yesterday
at noon?**

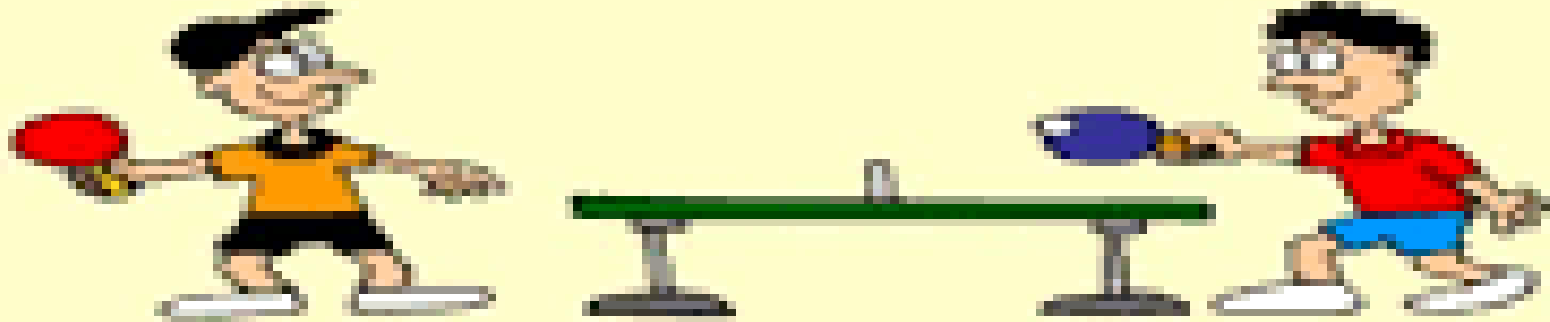


**He was playing
football at school**



YESTERDAY AFTERNOON

- They **were playing** table tennis yesterday afternoon.



Use the **simple past** for:

1) action that happened in the past and is

over, done, finished

Use the **past continuous** for:

1) action that was in progress at a specific point in the past
OR

2) focusing on an action that continued for a long time in the past



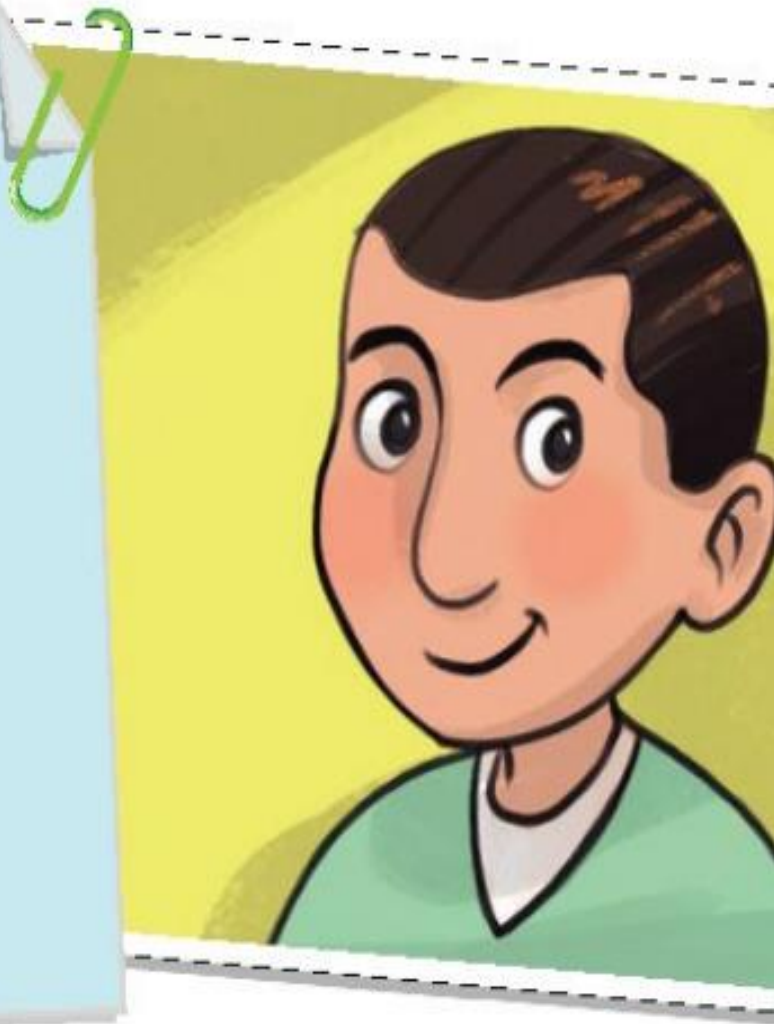
